Indus Hospital & Health Network Lahore Campus operational with **100 Beds**



Indus Hospital & Health Network – QF, NST & SMP Campus in Lahore, Pakistan, celebrated the operationalization of 100 beds of its newly-built, state-of-the-art hospital on June 5, 2022. In 2017, Qarshi Foundation and Naimat Saleem Trust collaborated with IHHN to lay the foundation of one of the largest free-of-cost healthcare facilities in Lahore, Punjab. In 2021, Mr. S.M. Pervez of the Din Group also joined the cohort and became an active partner. A generous amount of PKR 16 billion was donated by the generous founding donors to establish the hospital.

The Indus Hospital – QF, NST & SMP Campus is being completed in phases. The hospital will be fully functional with 600 beds and is estimated to serve 1 million patients, annually.

Pediatric Oncology Unit Inaugurated in Quetta

IHHN established a pediatric oncology clinic at the Sheikh Zayed Hospital, Quetta on International Childhood Cancer Day 2022. This is an effort towards decreasing the number of preventable deaths by providing free-of-cost treatment to all children with cancer and raising awareness about the global impact of cancer. Since the inception of the clinic, the residents of Baluchistan have been saved from traveling to Karachi to get cancer treatment from the Karachi campus.



Educational Events



More than **100 Pediatric Patients** graduated from Indus Kay Sitary

The sixth batch of 17 students completed their elementary-level education at Indus Kay Sitary – IKS (Stars of Indus); an elementary hospital-based school set up in IHHN for long-term patients; especially cancer. The students are mostly diagnosed with various types of cancer and chronic life-altering diseases.

IKS was initiated in 2018 with the sole purpose to provide long-term patients with efficient and effective educational experiences. Since then, more than 105 children have graduated from IKS, completing their elementary level of education while being treated.

The graduation ceremony was attended by renowned singer and the lead vocalist of the musical band Strings, Bilal Maqsood along with Veteran TV artist Sania Saeed and Sajid Shah.



Kushiyon Ka Eid Bazaar celebrated on Eid-ul-Fitr

IHHN celebrated a week-long Kushiyon ka Eid Bazaar with our childhood cancer patients on the auspicious occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr. The Bazaar aimed to provide all pediatric patients with the experience of shopping for Eid. Stalls for clothes, shoes, jewelry, mehndi, toys, and popcorn were set up with the generous support of our student volunteers, women ambassadors and renowned Pakistani celebrities, and corporates.

More than 1,500 children enjoyed the pre-eid festivals at the Bazaar, despite being confined in the hospital wards.

IHHN has been providing postgraduate education since 2009, and so far more than 200 professionals have completed their postgraduate education with training following WHO and College of Physicians and Surgeons (CPSP) criteria.
